2. Career Support:

The Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe prioritizes continuous growth and career advancement for its citizens and descendants, offering comprehensive professional development services. Our Professional Development Coordinator serves as a dedicated resource, ready to assist individuals in crafting impactful resumes that effectively showcase their skills and accomplishments, offer personalized guidance in navigating job searches, and help individuals identify opportunities that align with their career goals and aspirations.







3. Enrichment Funds:

The Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe Enrichment Program empowers our citizens with flexible funding to enhance their participation in cultural and community events. This funding offers a yearly stipend, providing our community members with the financial flexibility to seize a multitude of opportunities that contribute to personal growth, cultural connection, employment stability and community engagement. Through the Enrichment Program, Jamestown citizens have the ability to access extra support for various essential needs, including transportation assistance.
